



UKULELE GROUP LESSONS

STARTING MARCH 19TH

Four one-hour lessons 7pm to 8pm bi-weekly Mondays at Ground Zero Acoustic Lounge, in Parksville

These lessons are for the complete beginner and those of you who may have been singing and strumming on the ukulele but would like to move on to playing melodies. The two and three-part arrangements in James Hill's "Ukulele in the Classroom" book are perfect for learning to strum and pick melodies in a group or ensemble.

I will be covering TAB or note reading, timing, picking, strumming techniques and strumming patterns. The long-term aim is to be able to play arrangements of popular songs similar to the Prince song shown at the information night on March 5th. Depending on the interest, this course can continue in 4 session segments.
